## Goals of the CMSA Grassroots League

CMSA＇s Grassroots League is modelled after national and international best practices and Canada Soccer Grassroots Standards．Theleague strives to provide children with a developmentally appropriate playing environment that allows expression，creativity，and development to flourish． Match Day provides players with more time on the field，more time on the ball，and flexible matchups through an open roster system．
